CASHIER/FOH SUMMARY:

A Cashier/Fast Food Front Of House position focuses on the front of house with the restaurant. This involves taking customer's orders and correctly adding any modifications to the food item. Working with the ice cream station and drink fountain. Bagging ready food items so they will be properly packaged and presented. Using a microphone to announce to customers when their order is ready. Maintain a clean workspace and keep to hygiene standards. One will work directly under the General Manager or Shift Manager.

QUALIFICATIONS GUIDELINES:

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

EDUCATION/EXPERIENCE:

- High School diploma or equivalent preferred.
- Food Handler's Certification is required.
- At least 1 year of cook experience in a food service is preferred for Cook position.

COMPUTER SKILLS:

Basic computer skills are required in order to operate POS (cash registers) systems.

SUPERVISORY RESPONSIBILITIES:

The Cook position requires occasional supervisory responsibilities in the absence of the General and Assistant Managers.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS:

This position will require long periods of standing on hard surfaces, occasionally in warm temperatures. There is also likely to be extensive lifting of supplies and materials and moderate to loud noise. The use of hands and arms to reach for, grasp and manipulate objects is required. Finger dexterity may be required for cash register use. There will be constant exposure to hot equipment and oil throughout the workday.
